

ADMISSION POLICY

Welcome to Greenhill Islamic School We are delighted that you are considering our school for your child's education. Please review our admissions policy below to ensure a smooth

Eligibility Requirements

1. Junior Kindergarten (JK): Child must be 4 years old by September 1.
2. Senior Kindergarten (SK): Child must be 5 years old by September 1.
3. Grade 1 to Grade 8: Placement is based on age, academic records, and assessment results.

Required Documents

1. Birth certificate or proof of age.
2. Proof of residency (if applicable).
3. Immunization records
4. Previous school report cards (Grades 1–8).
5. Documentation of any special educational needs (if applicable).

Applications are processed based on the following prioritiesSiblings of current students.

1. Children of staff or alumni.
2. Applicants from the immediate community.
3. General enrollment, based on space availability and alignment with school values.

Application Process

1. Submit Application Form: Complete the online or paper form by the deadline.
2. Pay Administration Fee: A \$600 fee covers application, technology, and supplies. Note: \$150 of this amount is non-refundable.
3. Parent & Student Interview: Attend an interview/orientation session.
4. Assessment (Grades 1–8): Students may be asked to complete an entrance test.
5. Submit Required Documents: Ensure all documents are submitted on time.
6. Admission Decision: Decisions are made within one week.

Commitment to School Values

We expect students and families to align with the values and practices of our Islamic school, including:

1. Respect for staff, peers, and school policies.
2. Adherence to the Islamic dress code and prayer schedule.
3. Active participation in religious and academic programs.

Tuition and Financial Assistance

1. Tuition Fees: Detailed information is available in the admissions package.
2. Financial Aid: Limited scholarships and bursaries are offered based on financial need. Families must submit supporting documents to apply.

Waitlist Policy

If classes are full, eligible applicants will be placed on a waitlist. Offers will be extended as spaces become available, based on our priority criteria.

Re-enrollment for Current Students

1. Re-enrollment for the next academic year must be confirmed by April 30.
2. Students' continued enrollment depends on adherence to school policies.

Appeals Process

Families wishing to appeal an admission decision can submit a written request to the Admissions Committee within one week.
